Eligibility

Children in grades K-12 who live or attend school in Clark, Skamania or Klickitat county, Yale Valley Library District or the Woodland School District may enter. Homeschoolers should enter at the comparable grade level.

Bookmarks will be judged on...

1. DESIGN

- Use this entry form or an exact photocopy of the same size. Forms are available at any FVRLibraries location and fvr.org.
- Text may be in any language; words must be spelled correctly.
- **Keep important design details away from the line around the box or they may be cut off.**

2. ORIGINALITY

- Be creative and have fun. All art mediums are welcome and encouraged!
- Please use your original creations—no tracing, clip art, AI, or use of copyrighted images.
- Must be created by eligible K-12 contestants.

3. REPRODUCIBILITY for printing

- Use solid, vibrant colors to get the best results.
- Avoid lead pencils, sketches, and fluorescent colors which don't show up well.
