- Text may be in any language; words must be spelled correctly.
- Keep important design details away from the line around the box or they may be cut off.

#### 2. ORIGINALITY

- Be creative and have fun. All art mediums. are welcome and encouraged!
- Please use your original creations—no tracing, clip art, Al, or use of copyrighted images.
- Must be created by eligible K-12 contestants.

## 3. REPRODUCIBILITY for printing

- Use solid, vibrant colors to get the best results.
- Avoid lead pencils, sketches, and fluorescent colors which don't show up well.
