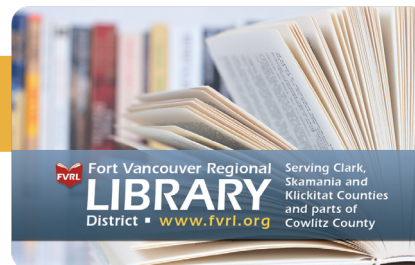

Your library district is community-funded. Library services are primarily supported by property taxes.

USING YOUR LIBRARY CARD



Borrowing items

- Physical items, like books, DVDs and CDs, can be checked out at any library or bookmobile. They can be requested in advance by visiting a library, at our website, or through the Ask a Librarian service. You may have up to 50 items checked out per card.
- Items are due in three weeks and can usually be renewed online, by phone, in person or through Ask a Librarian, up to five times if they haven't been requested by another patron.
- Due dates for electronic media, like eBooks, eAudio and eMusic, vary by provider. Please refer to the specific resource via our website to find details.
- FVRL participates in a program that allows patrons to borrow print materials not in our collection from libraries outside of our district through Interlibrary Loan. Due dates, renewal options and fees (if any) for Interlibrary loans are set by the lending library.

Returning items

- Physical items can be returned at any FVRL library or book return listed on the back of this brochure, and at Camas Public Library.
- Items are usually checked in the same day if returned during open hours. See details posted on remote book returns for frequency of check-in.

Fines

- FVRL does not charge overdue fines.
- Once an item is 28 days overdue, it is considered lost and you will be charged for the replacement value of the item. Returning the item in good condition will erase the charge.
- If your account has charges of \$25 or more, your privileges are suspended until your balance falls below \$25 by returning billed items or paying the charges.
- If your account has a balance of \$40 or more, the account may be sent to a collection agency and you will be billed a non-refundable fee of \$10.
- Interlibrary loan charges for lost items are a minimum of \$40 and your privileges will be suspended until the charge is resolved.

Notices from the library

- You will receive notices by email, phone or mail when your requested items are ready to pick up.
- You will receive courtesy emails when items are due soon.
- The library sends overdue notices by email, phone or mail when items are one and two weeks overdue.
- Bills for lost or damaged material replacement costs are sent by email or mail.

Parent/Guardian information

- Parents or caregivers are responsible for the choices of their minor children.
- All library accounts are private. You must have the library card to get information about the account.

What we ask you to do

- Be aware that you are responsible for any materials anyone checks out using your library card or number.
- Return or renew the materials before the due date.
- Report a lost or stolen library card to us as soon as possible.
- Resolve any fees on your account promptly.
