New Yale Valley Library Discussion to be Held on April 21

Community invited to learn more and provide input on building plans for new library

VANCOUVER, Wash. – Yale Valley Library District, working with Fort Vancouver Regional Library District, is developing plans and seeking input for a new community library in Yale Valley. Public is invited to a learning discussion with the architect, Karl Johannsen of JA! Architects. The discussion will be held on Thursday, April 21 at 6 pm at Yale Elementary, 11842 Lewis River Road, Ariel, Wash. The meeting will allow the public to provide important community feedback on the future library.

The new library will allow the Yale Valley community to have a dedicated building providing expanded hours, free internet and Wi-Fi, computer access, and meeting space as well as programs and workshops. Currently, limited library services in Yale Valley are provided through Yale Library Express, open weekly from 2:30-4 pm on Wednesday at Yale Elementary.
