

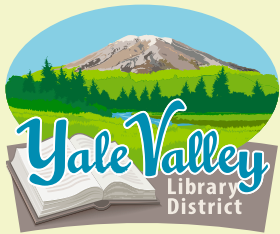

Building Updates

Planning underway for our own Yale Valley library

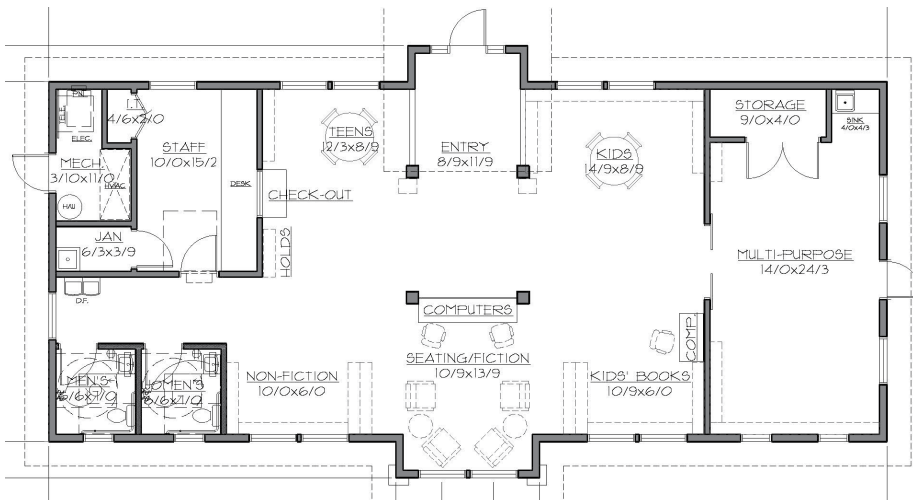


The Yale Valley Library District's (YVLD) plan for a new library building is underway. The district leased land from the Woodland School District to construct a new library and the board selected JA! Architects of Battle Ground to design the building. The firm conducted a community meeting in April to solicit public input for the new library and used the feedback to develop a plan that is currently under review by the board of YVLD. The proposed

building will be 2,000 SF with internet stations, meeting space to serve both library and community needs, as well as books and other physical collection items.

Plans anticipate additional library hours, a limited staff, and continued access to digital resources through a contract with Fort Vancouver Regional Library District, which currently provides library service to YVLD residents. The board hopes to have the library open by Fall 2017.

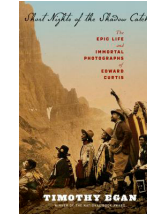

1. If you don't have one, get a library card at Yale Valley Library Express or any Fort Vancouver Regional Library District branch.
2. Visit the library catalog at fvrl.org or call 1-800-921-6211 to select items. Choose "Books by Mail" as your pickup library.
3. Look for available items in your mailbox in about a week.
4. Return items anytime at the book return at Yale Elementary School, 11842 Lewis River Road, or any FVRL location.

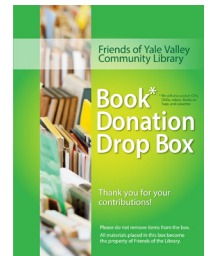
