If the book you want or the information you need is not on the bookmobile on the day of your visit, we can help you! You can also place your own holds on materials in the catalog just like at any library location and select your bookmobile as the pickup location.

The bookmobile is a public library and contains a wide variety of materials for both children and adults. Parents and guardians are responsible for the selection choices of their own minor children. Please ask library staff if you need assistance in locating materials to meet your individual or family needs.

- have mobility issues that prevent you from getting to the library
